I also bequeath to her as a Legacy a fine Peraphernalia
Besides her Part and proportion of my Estate
According to the Law provide My will and Desire is that
after my wifes part is taken out of my Estate that all
the remaining goods & what shall be

and form following.
First my will and Desire is that all my just debts be
duely paid without trouble to my Creditors.
I give and Bequeath unto my dear wife M^{rs} Elizabeth
~~the sum of~~ all her Jewels money and plate ^{after} ~~not~~ ^{to be}
given away and a sum of one hundred pounds to be
paid her of such of my goods not hereafter be-
queathed ~~as shall~~ ^{to} furnish her Room
for the year to her as Legacy & her Decemur
Besides her part share and proportion of my Estate
according to the Law provides My will and Desire is that
after any other part is taken out of my Estate that all
the remainder I give unto my dear wife Elizabeth
to have and to hold unto her and her heirs forever
and by my will and Desire after I am dead for the
use of my dear wife Elizabeth and her heirs forever
as unto my dear wife Elizabeth I give and Bequeath

One hundred pounds sterling when she marrys to be Com-
-lyed with so far as possible after I am dead unto my said
Elizabeth my daughter one Negro Man or woman, whom
she shall think fit to choose out of those that belong to
me, beside y^e mulatto Boy Daniel, I also give unto my
said Daughter Eliza. Two feather beds and furniture
with Curtains and Valances &c. with Table and Chest
of Drawers and furniture for one Room, together with
one of the new best standing beds (after my wife has
had her Choice) for the furniture of one Room as aforesaid
which she is to take her Choice of out of some of my houses
And that she have her provision out of my Stocke of
Cattle and Hogs till y^e time of her marriage together
with her Choice of Two riding Horses And that she be
allowed out of y^e produce of my plantations & Negroes
Twenty pounds sterl^a year to buy her Cloaths with till
she be married or her portion be paid her I also give
unto my said Daughter Eliza the largest Silver Tankard
and Silver plate the Silver Candle cyp^r with a Cover
Six of y^e best Silver Spoons;

I give unto my daughter Catharine £26 in Fifty pounds
y^e legacy

I give unto my daughter Catharine Corbin Esq. fifty pounds
sterling ^{as a legacy} having paid her portion already.

I give unto my daughter Judith Wormeley at y^e time of her
marriage Two hundred and fifty pounds sterling.

I also give unto my said Daughter Judith Wormeley and
her heirs forever Fifteen hundred Acres ^{out of my land} of land all
in a piece in Pamunkey Neck beginning at y^e upper market
tree and so to be laid off from thence by her Brother John
Wormeley and in case of her death with her heirs then to
Land to Come to the said John Wormeley and his heirs
forever.

I give unto my Son John Wormeley Esq. his heirs forever
all that my decedent of Land known by the name of
Wormeley Neck and all parcels since added to it and
all my Land in Pamunkey Neck except what
was before given to my Sister Judith Wormeley (to wit
with all the Rivers, Ruts and Lanes thereon)

I Give unto my Son Ralph Wormeley and his Heirs for
ever all the ~~of my~~ ^{my} Land of what kind or nature soever
with the Rights ~~of~~ ^{and} ~~thereof~~ ^{thereof} My will and
desire is that the Case may be so that Ralph or John Wormeley
should dye ~~with~~ ^{before} heirs that they have not alienated
or sold my Land given unto them then my Land
returne to my two Daughters Katherine Robin and
Ann both Wormeley and their Heirs and in Case they
should dye without Heirs then the Land to come to my
Daughter Judith Wormeley and her Heirs for ever
My will and desire is that when all debts portions &
Legacies are paid out of the produce of my Estate
that all my personall Estate with Improvements there
of as it shall be at my ^{sons} Ralph Wormeleys coming to
