Ranall, Robin Cooper, Francis Cooper, Mary, Capt. Mangary, Capt.
Harry, Charles at the Dog house also Rachel and his wife at the new
quartern and the millinery about the house and the Cookwench
Brady

I give to my Brother John Wormley and the Heirs of his body
lawfully begotten forever all the rest of my land not before dis-
posed of also the land before bequeathed my Mother after her
decease to my said Brother John to him and the Heirs of his
body lawfully begotten forever

I give to the use of the parish of Christ Church fifty pounds
to be disposed of by the ministers of the said parish
in plate for the use of the said parish

I give and bequeath to my Brother John Wormley all the
rest and residue of my Estate not otherwise disposed of
