 each seven shillings towards putting them to school
 I then I give unto Charles & Francis the sons and daughter of Robert
 Bennett deceased seven shillings each towards putting them to school
 I then I give unto Pleasant Hadenfield (an Orphan Child now under
 my care) twenty shillings to be laid out by my Executor hereafter
 named in schooling the said Orphan, & then to Teach him the trade
 of a Cooper or Carpenter, All the rest of my Estate I give to be equally
 divided between the children of my brother Curtis Hender
 And I do hereby constitute and appoint my said brother
 Curtis Hender Executor of this my last Will and Testament
 In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal
