In the name of God Amen I Thompson Wells of Middlesex County being Sick and Weak of Body but of sound mind & disposing memory for which thanks be given to Almighty God and calling to mind the uncertainty of this life do make and Ordain this my Last Will and Testament: First I give and bequeath unto my Wife one half of my Estate after my Just Dues & funeral Expenses are satisfied and paid and the other half of my Estate I give to be Equally divided Between the Orphans of Ingleton Deeds & Henry Greenwood Orphan of such Greenwood Deeds and desire that Mary Glen mother of the said Ingleton Orphans may receive her Childrens parts into her hands immediately & discharge my Execut. and what ever shall fall to Henry Greenwood share to be laid out in his maintenance & Schooling untill he shall be old enough to be bound out to a Trade. I do hereby constitute & appoint my Friend Tho. Brice Execut. of this my Last Will & Testament Witness my hand & Seal the 25th day of April 1743
