son in law Er Rack my lawful Executors of this my last will and tes-
tament hereby revoking and annulling and making void all other former
Wills by me made heretofore ratifying confirming and publishing and

declaring this to be truly my last will and testament and by me
made this second day of March ten thousand seven hundred and ninety
seven and in the Twenty first year of the Commonwealth
