In the name of God Amen I Alexander
Young considering the uncertainty of ^{my} mortal
life and being weak in body tho' of sound and
perfect mind & memory. Beseech the Almighty God
for the same, do make, and publish this my last
will and Testament in manner and form following
(that is to say) principally and first of all I give and
bequeath unto Lewis Kelly my wife's brother his heir
and assigns all that my Negroage or tenement Sit-
uated lying in an outgo of the River that is the
plantation where I now live Saving 1 to my wife
her right of dower and 2 to Susanna Thornton
confirming a verbal right made her for life of
a certain boundary of Land lying at various old
paths on the ridge ^{belonging} where she now lives & Mrs
Miller's and running a straight line boundary
from thence towards the river until it intersects
my line so as to take in her house and joined
field as thence following my line round to said

for the same, do Make, and publish this my last
will and Testament in manner and form following
(that is to say) principally and first of all I give and
bequeath unto Lavinia Kiddy my wife's brother his heir
and assigns all that my Negroage or tenement sit-
uated lying in Montgomery County ~~near~~ ^{on} the river that is the
plantation where I now live Saving I to my wife
his right of dower and I to Susanna Thornton
confirming a verbal right made her in life of
a certain ~~boundary~~ ^{boundary} of land lying at various old
paths on the side ^{the bridge} where she now lives & Mrs.
Mills & and running a straight line direction
from thence toward the river until it intersects
my line so as to take in her house and joined
field as thence following my line round to old
paths and so on to the beginning to her to live
peaceably without disturbance her lifetime.
I hereby revoke all former wills by me made
