I do bequeath my body to the earth to be buried at the discretion
of my friends and Executors I do give and bequeath all my lawful estate and
personal property to be paid by my wife and bequeath unto my beloved
wife Nathaniel Butler the full use and benefit of all my real estate
during her natural life I likewise the benefit of all my personal
estate as much thereof as may be necessary for her own and
comfortable support and for the rearing clothing & schooling
my children and likewise if any of the children shall be married
to give them as she may think it her duty to do all to the

done & denoting of no similar distinction. I by Salow & Adm all
my children boys and girls faithfully to serve their mother & father
remains my widow's & to share & come to their dearest eyes & to be
to 20 years and the girls to 18 years of age to share in the same
for lawfully & lawfully. I by Salow & give her power to bind
any one of my children either boys or girls apprentices to some
or other the way church & other till they are either of them are
of age according to Law providing they be treated according
to the requirements of the law for such apprentices. I by Salow &
bequeathing to three sons & three daughters & to the land
& plantation now in it to them to have & enjoy it at their
mothers dear when I value to two hundred pounds. If any of

proves the said land shall be allowed the value of the improve-

they cannot agree in the division of the land they are not
to go to Law, I allow it to be sold & the price to be so divided
if the family is not ~~divided~~ at the time of my wife's death

if the family is not agreed at the time of my Wife's death
the boys it not to have the lands nor they have't thereof till
all the Children are to have their living then they are
to have and enjoy it and their heirs forever 9^{thly} at my
Wife's death I do allow all my personal estate to be sold &
equally divided among all my children if any one or more
of my Children doth not comply with this my will & consent
they so doing shall have none of my estate I further do
