to mind that it is appointed, for all men once to die,
think it proper to ordain this my last will and testa-
ment. I recommend my body to the grave and my
soul to almighty God, who gave it, my body to be laid
in the dust in Christian like manner, at the discre-
tion of my friends who may be present at the time of
my death. As touching my worldly affairs of good
which it hath pleased God to prosper me in on this world
I will and bequeath the same as follows vizt, I will
bequeath and devote unto my youngest son Jacob Starbuck
and to his heirs and assigns forever, the better part of
my land, which shall be below the line which is to be
run in the manner, I pointed out to Samuel Starbuck
in presence of my two sons Philip and Jacob, both
trucks live on Tom's Creek and the western shore and is

in presence of my two sons Philip and Jacob, both
truly live on Tomi creek and the waters thereof and is
called the patent land and the new survey - also I
do and bequeath to my said son Jacob all the property
that I have given into his hand for his dwelling, also all the
house hold and kitchen furniture which I gave or sold
to him; it is also to be remembered that my said son
Jacob is to find me a decent support during my natural
life - I do now bequeath and give unto my son
Philip and his heirs or assigns forever all the upper
end or part of my land on Tomi creek, which
lies above the line I pointed out to Samuel Hargis
in the presence of my said sons Jacob & Philip - also
I give to my said son Philip and his heirs all the
property which I have heretofore given into his hand
for his encouragement - I give and bequeath unto the
said daughter, Rebecca Lytle wife of Philip

Water, Elizabeth surface, the wife of, Andrew surface
Hannah Bremer, the wife of Abraham Bremer, fifty
dollars each, I desire accordingly that all the money
if there be any left, after the payment of (my) three
daughters heretofore mentioned, in money I desire
the same to be equally divided among all my daughters
Rebecca, Mary, Katharine, Elizabeth, and Hannah.
It is also to be remembered that all the property in good
that either of my daughters have received of me, heretofore,
I give to them as part of their endowment.
I hereby nominate my two sons Philip and Jacob Hurley
to be my Executors, who is to undertake the execution
of my last Will and Testament, for which they are
empowered to settle all due accounts, collect all
money due to me, pay all money due from me, if
any I do owe, and to divide the residue of my
Estate after paying all the above legacies, and bequests
fairly and equally between my three children Rebecca
