called Spicer. To my Son David I give a negro Boy called Jack

called Spencer, To my Son David give a negro boy called Jack
at his coming to the age of twenty One, it being my wish that he live
with his mother until that age, His mother wish and desire that my
executors do dispose of by sale in the manner they may think best
for the interest of my family, my free lots in the Town of Salem
one of which a brick house stands, also a tract of Land adjoining
Salem containing One hundred and forty five acres or thereabouts plus

the tract of land containing one hundred and thirty five acres in the
County of Alleghany out of which said I wish my just debts to be paid
then with a small comfortable place of residence to be purchased for
my wife & family and at her death, to be disposed of and equally di-
vided among my children if any money remains after the above
paid off even with the money of any to be on interest and as my
children come of age each to draw their equal share William Bowe

I declare before God & man that I do give and bequeath unto my wife
for the Intervall of my family my five Lots in the Town of Salem
one of which a brick house stands, also a tract of Land adjoining
Salem containing One hundred and twenty six acres or thereabouts being
the tract of land containing One hundred and thirty five acres in the
County of Albemarle out of which said I wish my just debts to be paid
there with a small comfortable piece of residence to be purchased for
my wife & family and at her death to be disposed of and equally di-
vided among my children of any marry remain after the above
equated it with the money of any to be on Intervall aged or my
children come of age each to have their equal share. William Bowd
in the County of Hanover purchased of me one hundred and threysix
Acres of Land aforesaid & whole twenty pounds of which is only paid

in Court and proven by the Oath of Alexander H. Robertson as

1st day of November Court 1801 for the sum of One hundred Dollars one of the
Recusants herein named affirms both and enters and acknowledges
said will sincerely according to law certified to present him for
affirming after that time of his age from
