of the tract to be divided between my two daughters Patsy and Mary

I desire and dispose of in the following manner and give forth
I give and bequeath unto Joshua Holmes fifty acres of land adjoining
a tract which he bought of Alexander Holmes which he is to have
a deed for together with the fifty the fifty to be divided the balance
the tract to be divided between my two daughters Ruth and Mary
at the death of their mother or marriage the mill and the land
on which it stands together with land on the opposite side of the tract
to be divided between my son George and Elsie at the death of their
mother or the marriage at which time or either of the times Joshua
Holmes and George Holmes whom I leave the sole executor to
my estate in the tract all my personal estate appraised and equally
divided between William Holmes Joshua Holmes and my two daughters
Ruth and Mary the land before mentioned to be a part of the George
Holmes the mill together with the lands before mentioned to be a part

This last will and Testament of Enock Murhead deceased was presented in Court and proved by the oath of William Murhead a Justice thereof and continued for further proof. And at October Court 1805 the same was further proved by the oath of William Holmes a Justice. Witness hand and Ordered to be recorded
