In the name of God amen I George Read Junior
being in perfect health in body and in mind do will and bequeath
to my two sons Humphrey Read and William Read the Tract of
Land where I am now living containing Two hundred and twenty
two acres being and lying in the County of Montgomery and on
the waters of Little River and on a branch of Beaver Creek joining
Carter boys Land, and Charles Seneca and Thomas Reeds
and all the rest of my property to be equally divided among the
rest of my sons and Daughters at my and my wife's decease I
being a resident of Montgomery in the state of Virginia
acknowledge this to be my last will and Testament

whereof I have hereunto set my name and affixed my seal this
twenty fifth day of June in the year of our Lord 1803
