

G. Robinson's Will - In the name of God amen, I Gervaise Robinson
Esq. of the County of Montgomery and State of Virginia
being aged and infirm but of sound and
disposing mind and memory, do make pub-
lish and declare this instrument as my
last will and Testament. I direct that all
my just debts be paid. I give and bequeath
with my son William Robinson my negro boy
named Hanftry to him and his heirs for
ever. I give and bequeath unto my daughter
Letticia Oulton my negro girl named Anah
during her natural life and at her death, I

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give and bequeath the said Ann to my
grand daughter Gertrude Preston, to her
heirs forever. I give and bequeath

unto my daughter Cynthia my negro wo-
man Easter, my negro girl Susanna, and

my negro boy Adam, one Bed & furniture,

two bedsteads, Bureau, small cupboard,
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cherry table, small Walnut table, one half

dozen of Cherry chairs, candle stand, large

trunk, looking glass, andirons, brass candle

sticks, pair of tongs, and one half of my

china, queens and slip ware and kitchen

furniture to her and her heirs forever.

I give and bequeath to my son my
negro boy, Daniel, one bed & furniture &
bed stand, and the other half of my brass
quaker's Glapstone and kitchen furniture
to him and his heirs forever. I give &
bequeath unto my daughter Fanny Abney
my negro girl named Maria during her
natural life and at her death give and
bequeath the said Maria to my grand
daughter Gertrude Abney to her and her
heirs forever. I give and bequeath unto
my grandson David I. Griggs two cows
to him and his heirs forever. I give
and bequeath unto my grand daughter

Gertrude Robinson the daughter of my son David on becom-
ing a widow to her and her heirs forever.

I constitute and appoint my sons James and David Robinson
Executors of this my Will and revoke and make null &
void all other former Wills. In Witness whereof I have hereunto
set my hand and seal this third day of March
in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred
and fifteen
