of the County of Montgomery being weak in
body but of sound and perfect mind and
memory do hereby be thought by you for
the same do make and publish
this my last will and Testament
in manner and form following viz
First I give and bequeath unto my
beloved wife *Thofanna West* all
my freehold estate stock and imple-
ments of all kind also my three negroes
Cesar Bridget and Jack to have
and to hold the same during her
natural life and after her decease to
be sold or put to sale all except the three
negroes - I give and bequeath unto my
beloved son *John West*

eldest daughter Jane Roberts out of
the same when collected the
sum of one hundred dollars. I also
give and bequeath I also give and
bequeath unto my son John

West my negro boy Jack I also give and
bequeath unto my daughter Mary
out of the said sum when collected
the sum of twenty pounds. I also give
and bequeath unto my son Isaac

West my negro boy Cezar
I also give and bequeath unto my
youngest daughter my negro girl
Betsy I also give and bequeath unto
my above son John Roberts the sum of
fifty dollars ^{when} collected I also give
and bequeath unto my son Jacob

Wheat the sum of one dollar. I also
give and bequeath the balance of
my lands, property when sold and
collected unto four daughters Mary
Apostle Rachel Susan Elizabeth Dobbin
and Anne West to be equally divided
between them and lastly I consti-
tute and appoint my son John West
and my son in law John Dobbin whom
I appoint sole Executors of this my last will
and Testament hereby revoking all for-
mer wills by me made. In witness
whereof I have hereunto set my hand
and seal this 3rd day of June in
the year of our Lord 1814.
