This Last will and Testament of Jacob Shell deceased was
presented in court and proved by the Oath of William Brown a
Welsh Shroth, who says that Benjamin Gray and Samuel
Gray attested the same in the presence and at the request of the
Testator, John Preston, James Sallist and William Stavers more-
oath that the attestation in the name of Adam Wall they really
belong to be the ^{Montgomery County Wills 1795-1800} ~~and~~ ^{www.4g.org.uk/monco-wills} of Adam Wall deceased, and therefore
It is ordered to be Recorded; And on the motion of Jacob Shell one
of the executors therein named who made oath and came to court
bond, with security according to Law Certificate is granted him
for obtaining a probate thereof in due form.
