the heirs of such as are deceased all of whom I wish to come in
for an equal part Item 3rd I give unto Skyles Barnett (or
more) one tract of Land in Montgomery County on Brink

Creek containing two hundred acres 1 saddle 1 bridle 1 feather
bed & furniture Item 1st I give to my grand son James Barnett
son of David Barnett one acre coloured more, all my lands
not settled by my family I wish all my children and the
representatives of such as are deceased to share my Land equally
Item 3rd It is my desire that my sons James and David should
have my old tract of Land for which I have given them little
Bonds the line to run between them to the south line so as make
David's larger than at present I appoint my sons David John
Reid & Jas Barnett my Executors In testimony whereof I have hereunto
set my hand and seal this 8th July 1808

Know all men by these presents that Vincent Redman of the County of Richmond and State of Virginia both his executors constituted and appointed Richard J. Brown of the County of Westmoreland and State of Virginia to be my sole and sole attorney to sell and dispose of a certain Tract of Land in the County of Belknap containing five hundred and six by six acres, which I bought of John Jones. Dated by deed bearing date 18th November 1794 being a Tract of Land granted to the said John Jones Vincent and wife of Sam^l. W. Brown, who was wife of Zachariah Stanley, which said land
