and bequeath the same in the
following manner that is to say
I desire all my just debts and funeral
expenses to be paid.

only I give to my wife Mary H. H.
person the East end of my house
that I now dwell in (To wit) Two small
Bed Rooms and a fore room and also
apartments above said the rooms to gether

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2ndly I give to my wife Mary Thompson
person the East end of my house
that I now dwell in (To wit) Two small
Bed Rooms and a fire room and also
apartments above said rooms together
with all household furniture that
said rooms now contain together
with the cellar smoke house and
kitchen of said kitchen and five
acres ^{more or less} of land next to
the great road and fifteen acres
of my place land most convenient
to the mention house ^{the benefit} and
Orchard joining to said house
likewise the benefit of the one
third my barn and other things
and all the slaves that
I now own and two horses

Sufficient to Sustain Ist Ground and allow
us milk cattle and as many dry fat beef
and also Farming utensils Sufficient
Insuring for Natural Life or until his
second marriage -

3^{rdly} I give to my son Joseph Henderson
One Dollar -

4^{thly} I give to my son John Henderson
One Dollar - Montgomery County Wills, Deeds, Estates, No. 1809-1817
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that he will receive -

5^{thly} I give to my son Jonas Hender-
son a Survey of Eighty acres of Land that
s^d Jonas is now in possession of togeth-
er with one hundred pounds Lawful
money of Virginia to be paid him out
the personal ^{part of my} estate to be paid by my
Executors hereafter named.

6^{thly} I give to my other four sons (James)

and to my other sons (To wit)
Robert Henderson Samuel Henderson
Thomas Henderson and William Hen-
derson I will and bequeath the Tract
of Land I now live on containing
two hundred and seventy acres
also one other Tract ^{by survey} adjoining the
same on the North west side con-
taining Three hundred acres which
I do give and devise to my two sons of Land I desire to be
equally and impartially divided
by quantity and quality between the
said last mentioned Legacies and
further I will to my last three
named sons (To wit) Samuel
Thomas and William Hen-
derson my two other
sons to equally divide between

them at the disease or second marriage of my
wife - - - - -
and to my Two Daughters Sally
Mitchell and Polly Bean I will and
bequeath fifty dollars each as soon
as the monies can be made out
of the personal part of my estate
agreeable to law to be paid by my
son and to my youngest Daughter
Jane Henderson I will and bequeath
one Oak and Gable and at her mother's
Death or second marriage a Negro woman
named Ritten and her offspring
for ever and other household furniture
such as bedding &c. I leave it at the
discretion of ^{her} Mother and one
horse Saddle and Bridle worth
one hundred dollars

And lastly all the rest of my estate
both real and personal of whatever
kind it may be not herein ^{before} mention
~~ed~~ I leave to my three youngest
Sons, Samuel Thomas and William
to be equally divided between them.

And I do hereby constitute and ap-
point my two sons Robert Thomas
and ^{Montgomery County Wills & Deeds Estates No. 2 1800-1817}

of this my last will and Testament
and hereby revoking all other wills
or Testaments by me heretofore made
In witness whereof I have hereunto
set my hand and ^{affixed my} seal This day of
