Item 2nd I give unto my son Charles
Dyer 6 Three hundred Acres of Land lying
on the North side of Roanoke in
Montgomery County including the
mills for him and his heirs forever

Item 3rd I give unto John Dyer 6^e
Three hundred Acres of Land including
the bottom he now treads on the River
and a tract I got of James Smith of
fifty seven acres for him and his heirs

Item 4th I give unto my youngest son Abram Deane
two servants whereon he now lives for him and his heirs
forever.

Item 5th I give unto Anna Mitchell the sum
of one hundred pounds current Money of Virginia to be paid
out of my estate by the executors which Hundred pounds is to be
equally divided between Anna Mitchell and her three daugh-
ters Elizabeth Barnett, Rachel Barnett, and Sally
Barnett, for them and their Heirs forever.

Item 6th I give unto Sally (widow) the sum of one
Hundred pounds current Money of Virginia for her and her heirs forever.

Item 7th I give unto Rose Smith the sum of
one hundred pounds good and lawful money
of Virginia of Virginia and a Negro
worth Sixty pounds current Money of Virginia
for her and her heirs forever.
