Item 1st after the payment of my just

due unto my executors living wife
regarding her the choice of my house
and the choice of my bed and place
of burial and such a part of the plan-
ation as her son John Lee as she

think proper to leave and that those assets
be left to be enjoyed by her during her life and
then to be divided between her and her husband
in equal shares and after her death
to be equally divided among my
children hereafter named.

Item 2nd I give unto my dear friend
Dyer 300 acres of land lying
on the right side of Occaneech in

Montgomery County including the
mill for him and his heirs forever.

Item 3rd I give unto John Dyer 100

acres of land including
the bottom he now tenes on the River
and a tract I got of James Smith of
fifty seven acres for him and his heirs

Item 5 I give unto my daughter Anna Mitchell
two hundred acres whereon to rear her children and his heirs
forever.

Item 5 I give unto Anna Mitchell the sum
of one hundred pounds Current Money of Virginia to be divided
among her three daughters which hundred pounds is to be
equally divided between Anna Mitchell and her three daugh-
ters and left for the benefit of her daughters, and also
Barrett, for them and their heirs forever.

Item 5 I give unto Sally (deceased) the sum of One
hundred pounds Current Money of Virginia to her and her heirs forever
Item 5 I give unto Rose Smith the sum of
one hundred pounds good and lawful money
of Virginia for her children and her heirs forever
worth £100, to be paid in six months and
one year after her death and her heirs forever
