

Philip Warner of the County of Montgomery do make this my
last will and Testament in manner and form following to wit
I order that my executors hereafter named pay all my just debt
and funeral charges I leave to my wife Martha one third part
of my tract of Land containing in the whole about three hun-
dred & ninety acres during her natural life. Also during the
same period one negro woman named Hannah and a girl
named Jack, such part of my personal Estate not bequeathed
as she would be entitled to provided I had made no will. I direct
that the remaining two thirds of my plantation be rented by
my Executors untill my son Jacob arrives at the age of twenty one
years and the money arising from such lease to be applied equally
towards Schooling all my children except Beloy at which time
I direct that my executors lay off half the said tract of Land equal

years and the money arising from such lease to be applied equally
towards schooling all my children except Betsey at which time
I direct that my executors lay off half the said tract of land equal
in value to the other half which I give to my son Jacob. And the same
manner when my son John arrives at the age of twenty-one years the
other half is given him. I give to my Daughter Sally one negro girl
named Nancy. I give to my son Jacob one negro boy named
Michael. I give to my son John one negro boy named Daniel. I give
to my son David one negro boy named Moses. I give to my son David
the way more to all one year. And I direct that my executors sell at
Twelve months credit all my estate not particularly bequeathed
and pay forth to my Daughter Sally One hundred Dollars and
the remainder to be equally divided except as to my daughter

 Daughter Betsy who I give Twenty Dollars and no more. I direct and
 Order that the negroe Woman Hannah and the girl look after the
 decere of my wife together with their increase if any they have be by
 my executors divided among my Children Jacob, John, David, Sally
 and baby or sold at their discretion and the proceeds of sale in that
 can, to be equally paid to them. I direct and Order that in consi-
 deration of my land being given to my two sons Jacob & John, that
 they shall pay a foalborn my son Jacob when he arrives at twenty
 One years of age must pay his Sister Sally One hundred Dollars and
 when his Brother David arrives at the same age Jacob must pay another
 hundred dollars to him. When my Daughter Betsy arrives at the
 age of Twenty One she must be paid One hundred Dollars by my son
 John. I request that my executors loan at Interest the moneys arising from
 the sale of my estate, untill my children severally arrives at twenty One
 years of age at which time, & not before, they are to receive their share

whereas some of the negroes bequeathed to my children are young and
may incur expense in supporting them I order and direct that
my executors have the entire controul over them untill my children
arrive at twenty one years of age and any expense incurred in
supporting any of the s^d slaves must be taken out of that child's
part to which they belong and any profits that may arise from
the said slaves must in like manner be given to that child's share
to which they belong except as to the one given to my Daughter Sally
which she is to have at my death. I do hereby constitute and appoint
John Ingle & Jordan Lloyd my Executors to their my last Will and
Testament in conference that they will accept the administration
thereof & that the Court of Montgomery, may not demand security
to their Bond for the faithful administration of my Estate
Given under my hand and Seal the eighth day of March 1804

my executors have the entire control over them until my children
arrive at twenty one years of age and any expense incurred in
supporting any of the said slaves must be taken out of that child's
part to which they belong and any profits that may arise from
the said slaves must in like manner be given to that child's share
to which they belong except as to the one given to my Daughter Sally
which she is to have at my death I do hereby constitute and appoint
John Ingle & Gordon ^{Montgomery County Will 1796-1809} my executors to their my last will and
testament in confidence that they will accept the administration
thereof & that the Court of Montgomery may not demand sure-
ties to them I do for the faithful administration of my Estate
herein under my hand and seal the 14th day of March 1804
