In the name of God Amen I Thomas Goodson of the
County of Montgomery and Commonwealth of Virginia
hereby in perfect health of body and of sound
disposing mind memory and understanding hereby
beholden do make hereby last will and
Testament in the manner and form following

the not of all I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Sarah
Goodson the plantation on which I now live and have as
followeth By Beginning at my corner at the top of Banks Ridge
thence to the head of the middle branch and with the same
as it meanders untill it enlargeth with Harbours Line
and that part of the land lying south of the middle
branch known by the name of the middle branch tract
to be disposed of as will follow hereafter I also desire that
there be given unto my wife Sarah Goodson one third of
all and every of my personal estate together with said
land fully and freely to be possessed by the said Sarah
Goodson during her widowhood or untill her decease then
the land and personal the estate belonging to the said
Sarah Goodson at such decease to be equally divided

Parish Goodson at such division to be equally divided
among the children of William and Margaret Shelton
my daughter also give and bequeath the meadow
branch tract of land above alluded to and the other
two thirds of my personal Estate, to be sold & equally
divided among all my children except Joseph Goodson
who hath obtained his part already, except five shillings ster-
ling which I shall bequeath and request shall be given
him.

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Then first of all I give unto my son Thomas Goodson
his proportion of the proceeds of the said two thirds of my
personal Estate, and his proportion of the proceeds of the
meadow branch tract of land, unto my son William
Goodson his proportion of both, unto my daughter Nancy
Eason her proportion of both, unto my son Schuyler
his proportion of both, unto the said

my daughter also give and bequeath the meadow
branch tract of land above alluded to and the other
two thirds of my personal Estate, to be sold & equally
divided among all my children except Joseph Gordon
who hath obtained his part already except five shillings ster-
ling which I hereby assign and request shall be given
him. Therefore first of all I give unto my son Thomas Goodson
his proportion of the proceeds of the said two thirds of my
personal Estate and his proportion of the proceeds of the
meadow branch tract of land. And my son William
Goodson his proportion of both, unto my daughter Nancy
Eason her proportion of both unto my son John Goodson
his proportion of both unto the children of my son
James King which he had by my daughter

their proportion of both say one sixth with remainder
among none of my children. No others having been provided
for. Unto my daughter Mary Pogg her proportion of
both. Unto my daughter Martha with Henry her pro-
portion of both. Unto my daughter Jane Reavely her
proportion of both. And unto my daughter Rhody
English her proportion of both. I also gave and
bequeath unto my beloved wife Sarah Gordon
my family Bible to be disposed of at her decease
as she may think proper. And unto my daughter
Margaret Shaler the first volume of Davies Sermons.
Lastly I constitute my son Thomas Gordon and
and my son in law William Shaler Joint Executors
of this my last will and Testament. In Witness
