I William Bous make this my last will and testament after my lawfull debts are paid & will my property to be divided as follows

Item the 1st I give unto my daughters Mary or her heirs, Polly and Rebecca, two dollars each (as they have rec^d part of my estate heretofore)

Item 2^d I give unto my son William Bous two dollars having rec^d part (also before)

Item 3^d I give unto my son James Bous the upper end of the plantation I now live in, above to the corner end of the field above the orchard field running a straight line with the corner of S. Bous and to the ways to the river after this year.

Item 4th I give unto my son Joseph Bous all the

Balance of the tract of land I now live on down
from the above stated lower line of James Bonds
to the 5th line and my daughter Hannah Bonds
a tract of land joining the same as above containing
Sixty six acres, provided my son Joseph should
fail to pay her two hundred and sixty dollars
within four or five years from this date or as soon
after as she may demand it; But provided
the s^d Joseph should pay to the s^d Hannah
the s^d sum of two hundred and sixty dollars within
the above stated time, then I give to the s^d
Joseph the s^d land also the s^d Joseph is to pay to the
above named each their two dollars parts,
In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my
hand and seal this 28th day of April 1819
