In the name of God Amen I William McNally
of Montgomery County and State of Virginia, farmer being
weak in body but of sound memory blessed be God do
this ninth day of July in the year of our Lord One
Thousand eight hundred and ten make and publish
this my last Will and Testament in manner and
form following My Will and desire is that my
dear and beloved wife Rebecca have and hold all my Tracts
of land with all the buildings and improvements
thereon to have and to hold unto her and for her
own proper use and benefit during her natural
life and after her decease to be sold and divided
in manner following to wit I give and devise
to my son William McNally one third of the
money arising therefrom on condition that he takes
care of and loves his mother well while she lives

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in case no sale is made with the above condition
be perfect that there and shall only receive an
equal share with the rest of the legates. My
Will further is that the residue of the money
arising from the sale of my Land be equally
divided between all my children allowing one
equal share to my daughter Rebecca's three
Children so much for the Division of my Land

I further desire that my wife Rebecca have
a sufficient support out of my personal property
during her life. I also desire that so much
of the perishable property and of the Stock as
can be spared shall be sold at Vendue and
divided as follows first I allow my daughter
Matty Stacey thirteen dollars and the balance
to be equally divided between all my children
including a Matty Stacey and the Children of
Rebecca Johnson deceased that is allowing them
an equal share with the rest of the legates
I further desire that the residue

one equal share with the rest of the legates
I further desire that the property unvested
at Vander and for the use of my wife be
at her entire disposal. I constitute and
appoint my trusty friends James Barnett
Thomas Barnett David Craig, and David
Willis for any two of them Executors of this
my last Will and testament. In Witness
whereof I the said William M. Money have

At Montgomery September Court 1840 This
last Will and Testament of William McNelly
deceased was presented in Court and perused by the
oaths of Hammett and others and a
two of the Notaries there to and ordered to be Recorded
and at December Court following on the
motion of Thomas Carnell one of the Executors therein
named who made oath and entered into Bond with
Security according to Laws Certificate is granted
him for making out and entering in one form

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Now Motion by the presents that we James
Patten Isaac Batten and Christopher Trinkle are held
to and firmly bound unto John Tyler Governor of Virginia
and his Successors in the penal sum of One Thousand
Dollars to the payment whereof we bind ourselves our
Heirs jointly and severally With our hands
and seals this 4th day of September 1840
