In the name of God Amen. I William Watson of
Montgomery County being in perfect memory of body doth
make this & constitute this my last will and testament
in manner and form following, that is to say, all
my Just Debt to be paid as soon as my Executor hereof
named can make it convenient — Then I bequeath my
wife Nancy one negro girl by the name of Feller during
her natural life at her death I gave the said negro girl
Phelia to her son James. Also three Bees and further
I Bequeath to her as her old right and property, and all
other article of moveable property, which my wife by her
own industry hath procured and brought into my house
I desire it to be sold with my other property hereafter
mentioned and the amount thereof to be paid to her
for her own use I also Bequeath to my said wife two
hore brethren known by the name of Bob & Sam together
with a complete two hore wagon and harness which
said wagon & harness to be purchased and paid for
out of my estate and such of my live stock

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with a complete two horse wagon and harness which
said wagon & harness to be purchased and paid for
out of my estate and such of my live stock as my
Heirs have a right to claim seems to be solely
my intention and to receive the amount thereof
I further intend that all my negroes both men women
& children here or elsewhere and all my live stock
of every description all my household goods farming
implements and every kind of personal property
except such as is above mentioned to my wife to be sold at a public sale
by giving time with approved security, also two tracts
of land (to wit) one in Montgomery County whereon I
now live containing 415 acres by survey in the same
more or less with an entry bearing the same the other
tract lying in Polk County where I formerly
dwelt containing three hundred and eighty acres by

purchase the same more or less than price of land
I desire to be sold by my executor as follows the (long)
one third of the purchase money to be paid back
months from the day of sale and one other third
two years after sale and one third three years after
sale I will and bequeath to my son Benjamin
Malden one hundred dollars and to my son Mel-
son Malden I bequeath three dollars together with
one bond executed by said Mr Malden to Jeph-
Malden and then assigned to me.

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I will and bequeath to my daughter Sally Molly
three dollars

I give and bequeath to my Daughter Anna Malden fifteen
dollars

And to my son Nestor Malden John Malden
and Jeph Malden I will & bequeath the whole residue
of all moneys arising from the above mentioned sales of
negroes, lands, stock, crops, &c after my last debts and

negroes, lands, stock, crops, &c. after my death and
pay and two hundred dollars in cash and my share
to my son Reuben Watson over and above his proper
share with his brother John & Jesse Watson, for his
decease as executor in said will,

I appoint Reuben
Watson my sole executor in this my last will and
testament. I hereby revoke all former testaments, and
this only my last will and testaments, given under
my hand and seal this 12th day of October in the year
of our Lord 1809.
