Will 21 June 1835 [Abstract]

I lend unto my beloved wife Winny Jones the land and plantation whereon I now live together with five Negroes, namely Lucy, Cate, Spencer, Harry and Mills, during life or widowhood. After death of wife gives to son Wiley Jones boy Mills.

To Jane Jones, 3 Negroes, Martha, Lily & Tom.
To grandchildren John & Martha Jones \$5 each.
To his 3 children Jethro G. Jones, Allen Jones & Jno. Jones each \$1, and all the Negroes that I have not heretofore given & the land & plantation whereon I now live I say to be equally divided between them forever.

Lucy (dead) she had a child named Pleasant.

Cate do
Spencer (live)
Harry (dead)
Mills (alive)

Mary Louisa Jones was born since, & single & 18 yrs. old. had her part made up in money from others except of Allen (owner of Mills).

Jethro G. is 21

Allen (dead in Feb. 1854) of age, never mar[r]ied

Jno. live & 21 yrs. old.
