Mill 21 June 1835 [Abstract] I lend unto my beloved wife Winny Jones the land and plantation whereon I now live together with five Negroes, plantation "... Cate, Spencer, Harry and Mills, during namely Lucy and Mills, during and Mills, during life or widowhood. Afterddeath of wife gives to son To Jane Jones, 3 Negroes, Martha, Lily & Tom. Wiley Jones boy Mills. To grandchildren John & Martha Jones \$5 each. To his 3 children Jethro G. Jones, Allen Jones & Jne. Jones each \$1, and all the Negroes that I have not heretofore given & the land & plantation whereon I now heretolder to be equally divided between them forever.

Lucy (dead) she had a child named Pleasant. Cate do Spencer (live) Harry (dead) Mills (alive)

Mary Louisa Jones was born since, & single & 18 yrs. old. had her part made up in money from others except of Allen (owner of Mills).

Allen (dead in Feb. 1854) of age, never mar[rie]d Jethro G. is 21 Jno. live & 21 yrs. old.
