Examined

Be it known that I, Chetta R. Powell, of the City of Suffolk, County and state afore-
said being of sound mind, do give, grant, make and bequeath this my last will and testament,
First, I am possest with a House and lot in the town, or city of Suffolk, # Park Avenue,
the same being incumbered by a deed of trust held by S.E. Everett in said town or City of
Suffolk, and to set aside this incumbrance, and other incumbrances hereafter named, I
nominate and appoint my son, H.H. Powell as my administrator and distributor of all property
belonging to me at my death, according to grants and bequeaths herein made, I give, grant
and bequeeth to my said son, H.H. Powell, full power to settle my estate, I give, grant and
bequeath to my two youngest daughters, Lillie Rose and Babe Sis Powell my House and lot
on Park Avenue, in the town or City of Suffolk, subject to the following debts, First:
The deed of trust held by S.E. Everett, 2d, the cost of my burrial and funeral, 3rd, the
ammount of Fifty Dollars for my Husband's J.P. Powell's burrial and funeral. The said House
and lot (my Home place) # Park Avenue are incumbered by these last named three accounts,
the same to be first considered and settled, the balance and residue of said Home place,
Park Avenue, to be divided equally, between my two youngees daughters, Lillie and Babe Sis.
I give, grant and bequeeth to Babe Sis Powell, the Bed and other furniture that my Brother
gave me. I give, grant and bequeeth to Lillie Rose the Parlor Organ, I give, grant and be-
queath to my daughter, Anna Oliver, and my son James Powell, and H.H. Powell, Equally, all
other House Hold and Kitchen furniture not mentioned herein, after my Husband J.P. Powell's
allowance has been made. Lastly: I give and bequeath to the last named three Legatees, an
equal interest and devition in any interest may be due me from my father's estate.
