I give, grant and bequeeth to Babe Sis Powell, the Bed and other furniture that my Brother gave me. I give, grant am bequeeth to Lillie Rose the Parlor Organ, I give, grant and bequeath to my daughter, Anna Oliver, and my son James Powell, and H.H. Powell, Equally, all other House Hold and Kitchen furniture not mentioned herein, after my Husband J.P. Powell's allowance has been made. Lastly: I give and bequeath to the last named three Legatees, an equal interest and devition in any interest may be due me from my father's estate.
