Will, and declare this paper writing, to be my last Will and Testament:

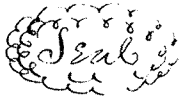
Item 1st. I desire all my just debts & funeral Charges, to be paid as soon

and her heirs forever. Item 5th. I give and bequeath to my son Thomas
J. Saunders, my horse, or any horse or mule which I may own, at my death
Item 6th. The balance of my estate, of every sort, kind and description
I give and bequeath to my sons Thomas J. Saunders and George W. Sau-
nders, and to my daughters Lucetta Davis and Margaret Jane Garner
to be equally divided between them, to them and their heirs forever.
Lastly, I nominate and appoint my friend Peter B. Prentiss Executor
of this my last will and testament. In witness whereof, I have

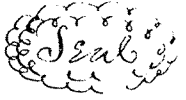
