and ordain this my only will and testament in manner and form following to-wch
1st. I bequeath to my son Elisha Duke, the Land and Plantation whereon I live, to him
and his Heirs, to his and their use and behoef for ever. Also I further bequeath to
him one bed and the furniture thereunto belonging, a Cart and wheels, one pun. chest
blue, a Hand Mill, Two Sleds, a wheel-sow and 8 pigs, Eight shotts, of the first choice
Three strokes of Bees, a Dutch oven, a large pot, one Woolen Wheel, one Loom
two Axes, three Weeding hoes, and one grubbing Hoe, and all the Corn, fodder, meat
and Peas that I have als the present growing Crops to him and his heirs forever,
2^{ly} I bequeath to my son Francis Duke, the Tract or parcel of land called the Cole-
man Land to him and his Heirs for ever als the piece or parcel of land I bought
of my daughter Martha Duke, see deed, provided however that if the said
Francis Duke should die without a lawful issue from his body, then said Land
or Lands, shall come back and belong to my son Elisha Duke, to him and his
Heirs forever. 3^{ly} I bequeath to my daughter Elizabeth, one bed and the Furniture
there unto belonging. To her and her heirs, forever. 4^{ly} I bequeath to Matilda
Ballard, one Bed and the Furniture there unto belonging, to her and her Heirs
forever. 5^{ly} My wish and desire is that all the rest and residue of my Estate
be sold at Public Sale, and the Money arising from the Sales thereof be equally
divided among my Children, provided however that Matilda Ballard
have an equal part with them. 6^{ly} I constitute and appoint my brother
Parker Duke my entire Executor. Done this 17th day of May, in the year of
our Lord One thousand eight hundred and eighty three in presence of the Wt
nffct.
