TO THE CIRCUIT COURT OF NANSEMOND COUNTY:

The undersigned, Lee Britt, Commissioner of Accounts of the Circuit Court of Nansemond County, respectfully reports to the Court that Thomas H. Barnes the Administrator of Frederick L.
