To the County Court of Hanover County:

Your Commissioner reports to Court that Richard L. Brewer the Guardian of Florence S. Gary has submitted her true Statement of all moneys received by the said Guardian or with which he had become chargeable or had disbursed, during the periods embraced in the foregoing account, together with the vouchers in support of his disbursements. That he finds a balance of \$2132:86 to be due by the said Guardian to the said ward on the 10th day of January, 1866, with interest thereon from that day. That the said account is supported by satisfactory vouchers, and that the said Guardian has given such bond as the law requires.
