Keene J. D. Murphy and others; also one bed and 1 bed stid. Item the 2^d.
I give, Will and Bequeath to my wife Sarah Holland, all the remains of my
property of every sorte, her life: and then to my two sons Frank and Miles
alio. witness my hand and seal.
