Examined

In the Name of God, Amen. I, Henry Baker of the County of Nansemond and State of Virginia being of sound mind and memory and considering the uncertainty of this frail and transitory life, do therefore, make, ordain, and publish and declair this to be my last will and testament. That is to say: first after all my lawfull debts are Paid, the residue of my estate real and personal, I give, bequeath and dispose of as follows to-wit: I give to my wife Francis C. Baker The place where I now liv, containing _____ acres more or less, lying and being in the County of Nansemond and State of Virginia, bounded as follows bounded by the lands of R.H. Baker and W.E. Baker, on West and by lands of James Milteer Decd. on the East, and by the lands of James L. Pierce on the South, to have and to hold during her life and after her death, the above named land to go to my Two sons, namely Jesse Baker and Jack Baker, and they are to take care and keep their Two single sisters so long as they remain single, (namely) Martha F. Baker and Josephphine Baker, Seckond; I give to Jesse Baker and Jack Baker Two carts and wheels, Third I give to Martha F. Baker One Feather Bed and Beding, fourth I give to Josephene Baker one feather bed and Beding.
