In the name of God, Amen. I, Job Holland, Senr. a native of the State of Virginia, and a inhabitant of the County of Nansemond in said State, being but weak in body but of sound mind and memory, do make bublish and declare this to be my last will and testament in manner and form following (Viz)

Item 1st- It is my will and desire that my Executors hereinafter named do in the first place pay and satisfy all my just debts.

2nd. I give and bequeath to my daughter Elizabeth Barnes the tract of land which I purchased of Henry Norfheet containing Two Hundred and fifty-two acres, more or less, together with the mill situated thereon, also one negro waman nam'd Rose and all her present and future increasewhich said negro woman she has now in her possession also one Cow & Galf and One Hundred Dollars in current money of the United States of America to her and to her Heirs and assigns forever.

3rd. I give and bequeath to my daughter Mary Lee, the following negro slaves, Isaac and Cate which she has in her possession and all their increase. Also one Cow & Calf, one Ewe and lamb and One Hundred Dollars in current money of the United States of America, to her and to her heirs and assigns forever:

Ath.I give and bequeath to my Grand children, namely Eliza Ann, Robert, Zachery Everitt and Dixon Holland, the Tract of land which I purchased of Nelson and Henry Hodges, also the following negro slaves namely Ned, Tom, Isaac, Mat, David, Elijah, Ben, Easter, Jane Phoeby, Sukey, Rachel, Nanny, Lydia, Lyshia, Hardy, John and their increase, also all the money on also I give and bequeath to my Grand Children as before named all the debts due me by bond, psomissory notes, open accounts or otherwise, allso all my stock of Horses, Cattle, sheep and not herein particularly disposed of; to them and to their heirs and assigns forever. If no issue, his or her property, be equally divided among the surviving Brothers and Sisters no issue, that all their property be divided between my two daughters, Elizabeth Barnes and Mary Lee,—

5th. I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Mary Lee one negro girl named Edy to her and to

6th. I give and bequeath unto my Grandson Robert Holland One gun (first choice) to him

7th. It is my will and further desire that my Executor or executors hereinafter named,

Hold all the property that I have given to my four grand children namely Eliza Ann, Robert, Zachary Everitt and Dixon Holland, children of my son, Zachariah Holland (decessed) in their possession until the said Children arrive to lawful age- it is my further will and desire that my executor or executors shall put up no Guardian Bond, but hold the property as my representatives.

Sth and lastly I hereby nominate and appoint Isaac Lee and James Barnes, both of the County and State aforesaid, the sole Executors of this my last Will and testament hereby revoking all other wills and testaments which may have been heretofore made by me. In witness whereof, I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal, this 11th day of December in the year of our Lord 1828.
