together with two negres Viz:t; old Sarah and black Sarah as also all my household goods
of what nature and kind sever within deers and without the sd. land, slaves and furniture
& to her and her heirs forever. Item I give and bequeath unto my son Christopher
Gedwin the land ecommenly known by the name of Pages and Beeunans to him and his heirs for
ever, containing by estimation Two hundred & Eighty three acres, also my negres Quash
and Mell. Item, I give unto my daughter Sephiah Gedwin my negers, Robin & Fortune to her
and her forever. Item I give and bequeath unto my daughter Ann Gedwin my negro Ned, Judy
and Jack to her and her heirs forever. Item I give and bequeath unto my daughter Mary
Gedwin my negres Jenny and Flora. Item, my will is that all the Tebasce which is Ten
theusand two hundred and twenty-four pounds of Tebo. contained in nine hogsheads, also the
produce of the tebasce shimed to Glasgen and such ether goods as may come to hand be to-
gether with my stere goods to be sold and the money arising thereby to be divided
amongst my children when they attain the age of Twenty one years or married, together with
the money arising from such debts as are due on my books, together with bills, bonds,
notes of hand & after the debts I owe are discharged out of the same. Item it is my will
and desire that in case any of my children die before they attain the age afsd. that that
part of my estate given them be divided amongst the survivors, Item it is my will that
if ther shall appear any ballances on my books due to me from any name of Jackson that the
same be struck off for I freely fergive them. I also fergive my Brother, Edmund Gedwin
his debt due to me. Item I give unto James Jackson my silver watch, and his cheife of
my best suit of cloesths together with my silversmiths Tools. Item I give unto W. Cary
Jackson my sisterin law fine Helland for six shifts and cambrick suitable to ruffle
them also enough of as rich black silk as any in the County to make her a gown.
Item, I give and bequeath to Michael Jackson as much fine Helland as will make him six
shirtswith Cambric suitable to ruffle them, with a fine Hatt. Item I give unto my
Brether Thomas Gedwin out of the debt he owes me five Pounds current money. Item I give to
my sister Mary Helliday, Patience Gregory & brether Iuemish to each fifty shillings to
buy them a mourning ring. Item I give to Sarah Meredith and Elizabeth Nerfleet to each
three pounds for their care of me in my sickness, Lastly I appoint my leveing wife
Jehanna Margaret Gedwin and my well beloved friend Christopher Jackson Gent: the elder
executer & Executrix of this my last will &c. In witness whereof I have hereunto sett
my hands & seal, dated this 12th day of October anno dom. 1747.

Item, I also give unto my son Thomas Gedwin my negre Bey Ned, son of Pegg & my negre boy Jimmy Tom, to him & his heirs forever.

Item, I give unto my Grandson Edmend Gedwin my negre man Will the son of Pegg my negre boy Jackson of Bess & negre wench Cate, daughter of old Bess to him & his heirs forever.

Item, I give unto my Grandson Jenathan Gedwin my negre boy Titus, son- Bess to him & his heirs forever. Item, I give unto my Grandson Jesiah Gedwin my negre boy Peter, son of Hetty to him & his heirs forever. Item, I give unto my Grandson, Joseph Gedwin my negre boy Quash son of Pegg and Sue, daughter of Hetty to him & his heirs forever. Item, I give unto my Grand daughter, Charity Gedwin my negre girl, Mell, daughter of Pegg, to her & her heirs forever. Item, I give unto my Grand daughter Amelia Gedwin my negre boy, Harry and negre girl Nan to her & her heirs forever. Item, I give unto my grand daughter, Juliana Gedwin my negre girl, Dinah, daughter of Hetty to her & her heirs forever.
