will.

I Justin Rawls of the County of Hansemond State of Virginia, do make and ordain this my last will and testament, in manner and form following, that is to say. 1

1 I give to my son Wm W, one certain note I hold against him for the sum of three thousand Dollars, and what interest there ~~may~~ be due on the same, dated I think some time in the year 1860; which said note and interest I give to him and his heirs forever

2 I give to my son Franklin my John Reed tract of land, also my pine box land known as the "Robert Han" land with the proviso, that in the event of his death without lawful issue, that the said lands shall return to my son Justin Ernest, to him and his heirs, and also with the proviso, that so long as any of my children continue to occupy the old homestead, where I now live, they shall have a claim upon the said tracts of land for light-wood and timber

3 I give to my daughter Mary Catherine, and to my son Justin Ernest the tract of land called the home tract, to be equally divided between them, to them and their heirs

4 After the payment of all my just debts, funeral and other expenses, I give the entire balance of my estate, to be equally divided between my three children, Mary Catherine, Franklin, and Justin Ernest to them and their heirs.

Lastly I do hereby appoint my two sons William W. and Justin Ernest Executors of this my last will and testament, hereby revoking all other, and former wills or testaments by me heretofore made.
