


Samuel Greecy's In the name of God amen I Samuel Greecy of the County of Nance

of every kind and work the farm the best he can, and raise and

of six years, he must pay all my just debts and at the end of
six years it is my desire that every thing be sold including my
land by my Executor here after named and to be divided as
as follows. I give to George A. Greecy fifty dollars, to him and
heirs forever 2^d. I give to my daughter Penelope M. Ferry fifty
dollars, to her and her heirs forever. 3^d. The balance of my Estate I
give to my children to wit: W^m G. Thomas C. Sarah F. Richard
E. James C. Robert F. and Lucy Greecy to be equally divided
between them, to them and their heirs forever. Lastly, I constitute
and appoint my son W^m G. Greecy my whole & sole executor to this
my Last Will and Testament and I also desire the County Court
of Nance and to permit him to qualify without giving se-

Lastly I constitute and appoint my son Wm G. Greecy my whole & sole executor to this my Last Will and Testament and I also desire the County Court of Nansesmond to permit him to qualify without giving security. G. Creasy, for obtaining a probat of the said will in due form.
