and desire that my son William G. Greecy take possession of all my estate
of every kind and work the farm the best he can, and raise and
take care of his brothers and sisters now with him for the space
of six years, he must pay all my just debts and at the end of
six years it is my desire that every thing be sold including my
land by my Executor hereafter named and to be divided as
as follows. I give to George A. Greecy fifty dollars to him & his
heirs forever 2^d I give to my daughter Penelope M. Derby fifty
dollars to her & her heirs forever. 3^d The balance of my Estate I
give to my children to wit: W^m G. Thomas C. Sarah F. Richard
E. James C. Robert F. and Lucy Greecy to be equally divided
between them to them and their heirs forever. Lastly I constitute
and appoint my son W^m G. Greecy my whole & sole executor to this
my last Will and Testament and I also desire the County Court
of Nanssemond to permit him to qualify without giving se-

into a bond in the penalty of One thousand Dollars, conditioned according to law, (but without security the will directing ^{that} none should be required of him and which said bond being acknowledged by the obligor therein is ordered to be recorded) Certificate, is granted the said Wm. G. Creech. for obtaining a probat of the said will in due form.

I Zachariah Porter of the County of Nansemond and State of Virginia being weak in body, but of sound mind and disposing memory, here by revoking all other wills heretofore made by me do make this paper writing as and for ^{my} last will and Testament in the following manner to wit First I desire that in case I should owe any debts at the time of my death that they together with my burial expenses should be paid out of any part of my estate thought best to dispose of. Second I give devise and bequeath to my Daughter Louisa Porter now being of age to receive such portion that I am disposed to give her, one Cow & calf bed & furniture & one chest. These making her equal with her sister Mary Byrd up to the date of this piece of writing. Third the ballance of my estate not herein before disposed of I loan to my wife Mary C. Porter & my daughter Louisa Porter all the ballance of my estate both personal and real during the life of my wife & at her death after paying all just debts & burial expenses I give devise & bequeath
