 Jasper County) This Indenture of the parties made this
 thirteenth day of September in the year of Our Lord one
 thousand Eight hundred and thirty seven between Lewis C.
 Holland of the first part, Charlotte Williams his intend-
 ed wife, of the second part, and Joseph L. Holland, a
 Trustee of the third part, Lewis C. Holland of the
 State aforesaid and his intended wife of the State of
 Virginia, Nansmond County, & Joseph L. Holland, a trustee
 of the State of Georgia. Witnesseth that whereas the said
 Charlotte Williams is seized to her & her heirs in fee

simple of certain property, to wit: Manerva a woman,
Dick, Essick, Tooke, Simon & Criss, and whereas a
marriage is intended shortly to be had & solemnized
between the said Lewis C. is to receive the following
property to wit, One four wheel carriage & two horses
with Sundries other property belonging to the said
Charlotte not above named as a marriage portion, It is
therefore covenanted & agreed by & between the said
parties to these presents in manner & form following,
that is to say, the said Lewis C. for himself his heirs
Executors & administrators, doth covenant & agree to &
with the said Joseph L. Holland, trustee as aforesaid,
his executors administrators & assigns and also doth
agree with the said Charlotte his said intended wife,
and that he the said Lewis C. shall & will permit &
suffer her the said Charlotte from time to time & at all
times from henceforth forever, to have to her separate,
sole & exclusive use & benefit, the entire property in
and to the said above negroes, to dispose of & purchase
others or any other property in lieu thereof as she may
think proper and to use, enjoy & dispose of the same by
gift, grant, deed, bargain, sell or divide as she the
said Charlotte may think proper absolutely, uncondition-
ably & unincumbered by any claim, interest or title
which would by the laws of said states arise to & be
vested in the said Lewis C. by virtue of said intended
marriage in fee simple or otherwise as she may deem
expedient and the said Lewis C. for himself, his heirs
executors, administrators & assigns, doth by these
presents intirely quit claim and release unto the said
Trustee his heirs &c and unto the said Charlotte all &
every right, title, interest & claim which they or any
of them might by virtue of said marriage have acquired,
and if said Charlotte should fail during her natural
life to make any disposition of said property which by
these presents she may rightfully & lawfully do, then
the same shall descend & be vested in her beloved Husband
Lewis C. Holland and the said Charlotte doth hereby
accept the same for the purpose above mentioned & lastly
the said Lewis C. in pursuance & full performance of his
said recited agreement & divers other good & valuable
causes & considerations him thereunto moving hath & by
these presents doth absolutely establish, satisfy &
confine as will herein before recited indenture of
assignment & settlement as the several conditions stipu-
lated & expressed. In testimony whereof the said Lewis
C. hath hereunto set his hand & affixed his seal the
day & year above written.
