1. First I desire that my Body be decently buried in a manner corresponding to my estate and situation in life, but with as little expense as may be consistently there with.

2. Secondly- As to such worldly estate as I die seized and possessed of whether the same be real personal, or mixed I give devise and bequeath the same wholly and entirely to my three beloved children to share and share equally and alike and from heir to heir forever in fee simple absolute, namely, (My beloved daughter Ida Langford Savage, My beloved son Berry A. Langford and My beloved Son Marard Langford.

3. Thirdly- I desire that my beloved children to give out of my estate to my six grand children viz. my beloved grand daughter Fannie Moore, My beloved grand son Isiah Moore My beloved grand daughter Mollie Moore, My beloved grand son Charlie Moore, My beloved grand daughter Zilphia Moore, and my beloved grand daughter Linda Moore, the sum of one (\$1 00/100) Dollar each.

4. Fourth- I appoint my beloved Son Berry A. Langford Executor of my last will and devise that no security be required of him of such.

5. Fifth I hereby revoke all previous wills and codicils hitherto made by me.
