Bradshaw and Theodosia Turner, my daughter, under Bond with security, for two thousand dollars, my lawful executor and executrix to all intents and purposes to execute this my last will and testament according to the true intent and meaning of the same and every act and clause thereof, hereby revoking and declaring utterly void all other wills and testaments by me heretofore made.
