The said lands are bounded on the North by the lands of P. D. Camp South by the lands of P. D. Camp and the Somerton Creek, West by the lands of P. D. Camp and John A. Davidsen and on the East by the lands of Thomas Hunter, M. E. Howell and John Eley Beene. Situated in the upper part of Hely Neck Magisterial District Nansemond County near South Quay Va. Containing fifty acres more or less. Given my hand and seal this 20d, day of April, 1914.

I hereby give devise and bequeath all of my estate, real and personal unto my wife, Mary Emma Baines for her natural life, and at her death unto my children, viz, Nettie Lillian Yates, Edna Flerine Baines, Harvey Baines, Gurney Baines, Lleyd Baines, Obie Baines, Heratic Baines, Judge Paul Baines and Frank Nerah Baines, to share and share alike. To Joseph Hurley Baines, I give nothing, he having been provided for during my life. I also direct that, should any child of my blood family leave his mother before he shall have reached the age of twenty one years, the sum of \$100.00 (one Hundred Dollars), shall be deducted from his share for each and every year that he continuously remains away from his mother, unless he does so with his mothers expressed consent—
