

In the name of God, Amen: I, Moses E. Horten of Nanssmond County, do make this my last will and testiment, as follows:

1st. I give and bequeath unto my daughter, <sup>Catherin</sup> Catherin Eason, the sum of one dollar.  
2. I give and bequeath unto my two sons, Herbert Horten and Newton Horten, each, the sum of one dollar.

3. I give, bequeath and devise unto my beloved wife, Mary E. Horten, my entire tract of land, known as my home tract, together with all my household and kitchen furniture of all and every kind, all farming utensils & implements, buggy & harness and one mule, or any mule or horse which I may possess at my death, and all and any chattel property, to have and to hold in fee simple during her natural life. At her death or should she marry, then all of the above described land, chattels and property of every and all kinds, shall revert to my four children, viz: Catherin Eason, Herbert Horten, Newton Horten and Brantly Horten and to be severally and equally divided among them.

I desire and request that my son Brantly Horten, shall live and have a home at the homestead during his minority.

I hereby appoint, <sup>G. Jackson</sup> G. Jackson, Executor of this my will. I hereby revoke all previous wills and codicils hitherto made by me.
