

Wm Frost's Will In the name of God, Amen: I Pilsillw Frost, of the upper Parish of Hansemond County, and state of Virginia, feeling my self sicke in mind through weaknesse do make and ordain this my last will and Testament: What God has blessed me with I dispose of as follows: First I give my soule to God, my body, to the Earth, to be buried in a Christian like manner, at the discretion of my herein mentioned Executor; Secound; I give to my daughter Emeline Myrill Cash to the amount of Twenty Dollars, also Fifty dollars in Cash, for the benefit of her three Children, Marphenia, William James, & Carly Matthew Myrill, to them for the benefit of schooling said Children, for one year or more, to her the said Emeline Myrill, her heirs & assigns forever: Third, I give to my daughter Hester Ann Frost, one bed & furniture, the one that stands in the little room, one Beauso & one Poplar Table, fifty dollars in Cash, to her the said Hester Ann Frost, her heirs & assigns forever. Forth, I give to my son, William Frost, Two Dollars fifty Cents, to him, his heirs & assigns forever. Item Fifth, I give to my daughter Calsandria Ellis, one Cow, one bed and furniture, the one I am now resting upon, to the said Calsandria Ellis, for her heirs & assigns forever. Item Sixth, I give to my Niece Rochsanna Duke, one bed & its furniture, the one up stairs, to her heirs and assigns, forever. Seventh: I give Ten dollars, to James H. Myrill, for building up my grave yard, which is to be Potts, railing and heart, rails. Eight. My will and desire is, that all the proceeds of my property, not before given away after paying my just Debts and burial Expenses be equally divide d between my three grand children, Emeline Myrill, Hester Ann Frost & Calsandria Ellis, Except my daughter Emeline Myrill, she to only have one fifth of the proceeds, to them, their heirs & assigns forever. Item Ninth & Lastly, I will and desire, that my son in law Robert C. Ellis execute this

year or more, to her the said Emeline Mygale, her heirs & assigns forever; Third, I give to my daughter Hester Ann Frost, one bed and furniture, the one that stands in the little room, one Bureau & one Poplar Table, fifty dollars in Cash, to her the said Hester Ann Frost, her heirs & assigns forever. Fourth, I give to my son, William Frost, Two Dollars fifty Cents, to him, his heirs & assigns forever. Item Fifth, I give to my daughter Cassandra Ellis, one Cow, & one bed and furniture, the one I am now resting upon, to the said Cassandra Ellis, for her heirs & assigns forever. Item Sixth, I give to my Niece Rochsanna Duke, one bed & its furniture, the one up stairs, to her heirs and assigns, forever. Seventh: I give Ten dollars, to James H. Mygale, for building up my graveyard, which is to be Posts, railing and heart rails. Eighth, My will and desire is, that all the proceeds of my property, not before given away after paying my just Debts and burial Expenses, be equally divided between my three grand children, Emeline Mygale, Hester Ann Frost & Cassandra Ellis, Except my daughter Emeline Mygale, she to only have one fifth of the proceeds, to them, their heirs & assigns forever. Item Ninth & Lastly, It is my will and desire, that my son in law Robert C. Ellis execute this, my last will & Testament, in testimony whereof, I affix my hand & seal, this Twentieth day of September, One thousand Eight hundred and Seventy. 20th. September 1870

Edith Saunders I, Edith Saunders, of Nansemond County, Virginia, do make, publish & will, and declare this paper writing, to be my last will and Testament:

Item 1st. I desire all my just debts & funeral charges, to be paid as soon after my decease, as practicable. Item 2nd. I give and bequeath to my grand daughter Amelia Thomas Saunders, (daughter of my son Thomas J. Saunders) my best, bed,stead, bedding to her and her heirs forever. Item 3rd. I give and bequeath to my daughter Lucretia Davis, my next best bed,stead, bedding to, one patch work bed quilt, first choice, and one loom & gear, to her and her heirs forever. Item 4th. I give and bequeath unto my daughter Margaret Jane Garner, one patch work bed quilt, second choice, to her and her heirs forever. Item 5th. I give and bequeath to my son Thomas J. Saunders, my horse, or any horse or mule which I may own, at my death. Item 6th. The balance of my estate, of every sort, kind and description I give and bequeath to my sons Thomas J. Saunders and George W. Saunders, and to my daughters Lucretia Davis and Margaret Jane Garner to be equally divided between them, to them and their heirs forever.
