Will.

In the name of God. Amen. I, Risbey Raby, of the Upper Parish of Nansmond
County, State of Virginia being in an infirm state of health but of sound mind
and disposing memory recollecting the uncertainty of this life, do make and
ordain this to be my last will and testament revoking all other wills by
me heretofore made. And as to my worldly estate which it hath pleased
God to bless me with, I give and dispose of as follows. I give to my daughter
Barsheta Raby two feather beds and clothing and one white Counterpan
and other clothing, one table, one chest, one spinning wheel and cards, -
two cooking pots and one spider and one frying pan, one loom, one set
of crockery ware consisting of cups, saucers, dishes, bowls &c. three stool=
bottom chairs with other household and kitchen furniture. Witness my hand
and seal, this 8. th. day of February 1862.
