

be my Last Will and Testament, in manner and form, following: that
is to say. First, It is my will and desire, that all my just debts be paid
and my Executor hereinafter named is requested to perform that duty, as
early as circumstances will allow. Secondly, I give unto my much beloved

son, Joseph Prentis Webb, one thousand dollars of my Norfolk City stock, to him and his heirs forever. Thirdly. I give and bequeath unto my dearly beloved wife, Margaret Susan Webb, all the balance of my estate of every description whatsoever, both real and personal, during her natural life, and at her death, the same to descend to my said son Joseph Prentis Webb, to him and his heirs forever. If however my said son should die, before my said wife, unmarried and without issue, then I give and bequeath the same, to her, my said wife, and her heirs forever. Fourthly. If my Executrix, shall deem it proper to sell or exchange any property, she is hereby fully authorized to do so. Lastly. I constitute and appoint my beloved wife Margaret Susan Webb, whole and sole Executrix of this my last will and testament, revoking all other wills and testaments by me, heretofore made, and desire that the Court of Probat. will not require her to give security for the trust, hereby reposed in her.


