Will I give and bequeath unto my daughter Henrietta Parker, the proceeds  
of a claim I have against the United States Government for work  
on Fortifications in 1863 and which claim is now in the hands  
of C. C. Brown of Norfolk for collection. I appoint my said daughter  
Henrietta Parker my Executor and request the Court to require of  
her no security for the execution of the Trust. Given under my hand  
and Seal, this 20th day of July 1869.
