Ulster Nassau and State of N<sup>Y</sup> do hereby make this my last will and  
testament in manner and following that is to say:  
1st: I give to my son Benjamin the farm on which I now reside, and

his heirs forever, and Five Hundred Dollars in cash, and one single barrel of percussion gun:

3rdly: I give to my daughter Martha Ann the Dashill tract of land containing 100 acres more or less, & Five Hundred Dollars in cash to her & her heirs forever.

4thly: I loan unto my beloved wife, all the perishable part of my estate during her natural life, at her death I desire that all the perishable part of my estate be sold, and I desire for my daughter Martha Ann to have one half of the money.

5thly: I desire after paying all the just debts & funeral expenses for the remainder to be equally divided between my two children Benjamin & Martha Ann.

Lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my friend, Mr. W. R. Butler, & my Brother Hollard, below, Execs of this my last will and Testament, hereby revoking all other or former wills or Testaments by me heretofore made.
