In the name of God, Amen, I, Susana Edwards of the County of Nansemond, State of Virginia, being of sound mind and judgment, thank God for the same, do make this my last will and Testament as follows.
1st- First, I direct that my body be decently buried in a manner corresponding to my estate and situation in life, but with as little expense as may be consistently therewith.
2nd-Secondly, As to such worldly estate as I die seized and possessed of, whether the same be real; monies in bank, personal or mixed, I give devise and bequeath, wholly and entirely without reservation or exception forever to my beloved son James Edwards.
3rd- THirdly, I appoint my beloved son James Edwards executor of this my last will, and desire that no security be required of him of such.
4th-Fourth, I hereby revoke all previous wills and codicils either to made by me.
