Whitmell Savage. In the name of God Amen. I Whitmell Savage of Farnsmondo
Will: County and State of Virginia do hereby make my Last Will and
Testament, revoking all other and former Wills by me at any time
heretofore made. First: I direct that all my just debts and legal
and proper charges be paid. Second: I give and bequeath unto my
son William J. Savage one tract of land containing fifty acres, -
which he now lives on the said tract of land he has a deed for;
also one cow and one feather bed now in his possession, to have
and to hold to him and his heirs and assigns forever. Third: I give
and bequeath unto my son Simon Savage, one cow and Calf, one horse,
one feather bed and Cloathing, all of which he has in his possession to
him and his heirs and assigns forever. Fourth: I lend to my wife,
Sophia Ann Savage, one negro woman Charlotte and her increase,
if any, so long as she may live also I lend to my wife Sophia
^{Ann} ~~my~~ house and Plantation whereon I now live so long as she
lives ^{to my wife} ~~and~~ ^{and} ~~my~~ ^{one} ~~one~~ ^{Curtain} feather bed and cloathing as long as she may live.
May live. Fifth: I give to my daughter Adaminta, one feather bed
and cloathing first choice up stairs in the big room to her forever.
Sixth: I give to my daughter George Anna, one feather bed and
cloathing up stairs in the big room, to her and to her heirs and
assigns forever. Seventh: I give to my daughter Mary H. Savage, the
feather bed and cloathing which I lent to my wife after the death of
my wife I also give to my daughter Mary H. Savage one Bureau, after
the death of my wife Sophia Ann, to her and her heirs forever. Eighth:

I lend to my son James M. Savage, my house and plantation on which I live, after the death of my wife, during his natural life, and after his death, if he should die without a lawful heir I give the same to be equally divided between my three daughters Adaminta, George, Ann and Mary F. Savage notwithstanding if either of my daughters should die without a lawful heir, then her portion to go to the living daughters named in this item I give to my son James M. Savage, one feather bed and clothing to him and his heirs forever.


Ninth. After the death of my wife Sophia Ann. I give all of my negroes to my three daughters, to be equally divided between Adaminta, George, Anna and Mary F. Savage, the negroes to be divided are the following. Charlotte Ann, Malissa and increase, Allis an increase and Moses. Tenth. I leave all my Chattel estate, to be sold and out of the money arising therefrom all my just debts, if any, to be paid and the remainder to be equally divided among my heirs. Lastly, I do hereby appoint my sons Simon Savage and James M. Savage Executors of and to this my last Will and Testament. In testimony whereof, I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 30th day of October 1864
